The Oxford Public Library serves a charming, historical community of 20,000 + residents in northern Oakland County. The library facility itself is approximately 24,000 sq ft and houses a collection-size consistently around 82,000. Pre-pandemic the library circulated over 234,000 items annually. 2021 circulation estimates are expected to meet or exceed the 200,000 mark. On average, the Library hosts 640 community-based programs annually that are attended by nearly 37,000 participants. In November of 2021, Oxford taxpayers will be voting on a major capital bond campaign to expand its Youth and Adult Services Departments, and to renovate its existing facility. If successful, the Library is expected to break ground on this project sometime in mid-2022.
