MeLCat NCIP Update

TLN staff continues to work with MCLS to implement NCIP between the shared system and MeLCat. MCLS plans to have a couple of shared system libraries using the NCIP protocol prior to the MeLCat server migration at the end of the year. MCLS would like to bring the remaining shared system libraries up on NCIP in groups of five after the server migration.

MeLCat Reminder

It has come to our attention that a few shared system libraries have been getting MeLCat requests for AV items that are not videocassettes. Shared system libraries had to agree as a group on what item types they would share with MeLCat libraries. Here is the list of item types that are currently shared with MeLCat: BOOK, JBOOK, JPAPERBACK, JVIDEO, LARGEPRTBK, PAPERBACK, TBOOK, TPAPERBACK, TVIDEO AND VIDEO. Requests that come in from MeLCat are based upon those item types. So, if you have given a DVD the item type of VIDEO it will make that item eligible for request in MeLCat. With that in mind, please use care when assigning item types when items are linked.

Hartland Migration – Update

Policy profiling work has begun for the Hartland library's migration to the shared system, with Hartland and TLN staff working to complete data mapping spreadsheets. The Library Policies for Hartland's Village library and for the Crossroads branch have been created on our production server. A test load of Hartland's data will be loaded on to our test server in mid-October, with 2-3 weeks of data testing to follow. Hartland's go live date on the shared system is set for November 19. No downtime of the shared system is expected for any work involved in the Hartland migration.

Odilo Integration into eResource Central

TLN is working with SirsiDynix and Odilo to Beta Test the integration of Odilo eBooks into the Enterprise Catalog using eResource Central (eRC). Once this integration is complete, your patrons will be able to search for, place holds, and checkout/download Odilo eBooks through the Enterprise catalog. White Lake Township Library volunteered to be our guinea pig during the beta test process and Odilo materials now display in the White Lake Township Library Enterprise instance.

Where we currently stand with the Odilo beta test integration:

- Odilo material appears in the catalog when searching White Lake's Digital Collection. The Odilo materials that currently appear in Enterprise are from a test copy of our Odilo collection; once beta testing is complete, it will point to our live Odilo collection
- The download button currently does not function correctly
- Hold functionality for Odilo items has not been implemented yet
